



Observation & Conservation Expedition **BIRD WATCHING SAFARI**

The lagoon of Oualidia is an exceptional ecological site for bird conservation in Morocco that extends over 12 km. The importance is such that Oualidia is part of the “Ramsar convention” on the list of “Wetlands of International Importance” that requires a permanent observation by bird conservation associations.

The site consists of a lagoon, salines and salt marshes that are separated from the sea and a sandy beach by a system of sand dunes. Most water bird species that migrate the east-Atlantic route make this site a stopover. According to the season, you can observe some limicoles, grey herons, spatulas, big cormorants, pink flamingos, storks...

Founded on a deep desire to protect and celebrate this incredible ecosystem, La Sultana Oualidia decided to go further and raise more awareness amongst guests and staff by providing educational Bird-Watching safari.

Raise your awareness of this ecosystem and kayak up the lagoon to encounter many bird species with the help of a guide.
