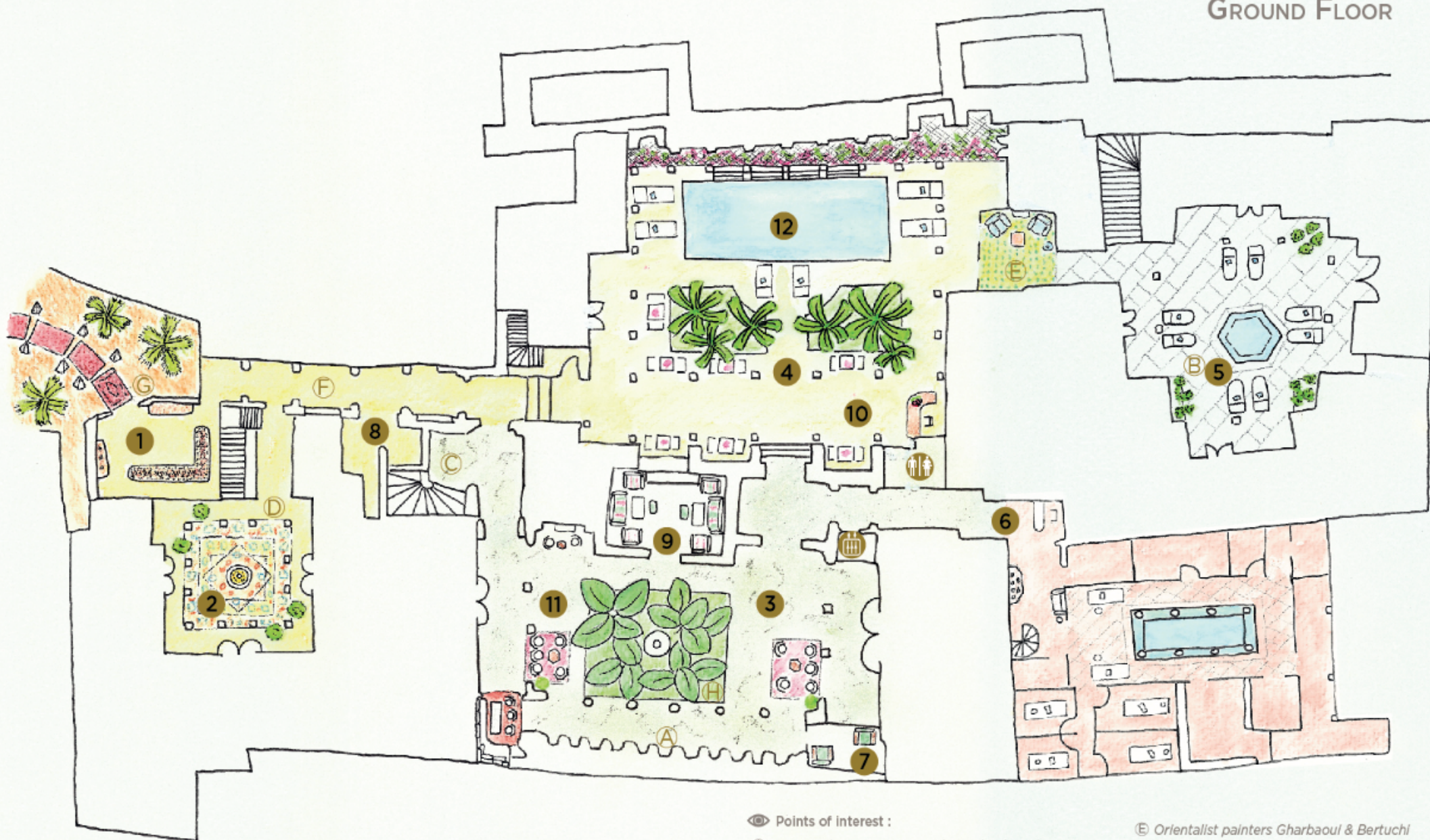

👁 Points of interest :

- (A) Restored water fountains dating back to the French Protectorate
- (B) Hand-made Moroccan carved white plaster inspired by the Saadian patterns
- (C) Display of a textile pattern book archive dating from the 1920s in a 'Tadelakt' striped stair representing Water, Fire and Air
- (D) Mosaic 'Zellige' with the same pattern found in the original house before the refurbishment

- (E) Orientalist painters Gharbaoui & Bertuchi intertwined in ochre tone
- (F) Little street that provided access to original Moroccan houses 'Riads'
- (G) Gilded copper entrance door with the inscription in the Tadlack of « Kan Ya Makan » (Once upon a time), similar to the door of the Mausoleum of the Saadian Princes
- (H) Turtles' Home in the tropical Elephant Ear plants garden
